### Update on the operation of the Cwmdu Inn, Shop, Post Office & Premises

Like all businesses, we have had to consider the implications of the Covid 19 guidelines. At a meeting held on 25<sup>th</sup> August the following decisions were made not only to comply with the regulations but also to protect the well being of staff, volunteers and the community.

#### Bar

The inside premises are now open. Seating has been arranged to comply with the social distancing regulations and we ask you to respect this.

As the numbers permitted inside the building are restricted, access will be on a first come first served basis. The garden will remain open as an overflow area or for those preferring to remain outdoors.

We are looking to extend the bar opening hours to include Saturday evenings. Further details will be posted at a later date.

There are no plans to seek to licence the garden. Under the present restrictions it was felt there would be no benefit from doing so. This will be looked at again should the situation change.

#### Music

Unfortunately no live music is permitted under the present guidelines, whether held inside or outdoors, therefore we cannot allow the folk club or any similar event to take place on Tafarn premises. The advice of Carmarthenshire County Council has specifically been sought on this matter.

#### Kitchen

The kitchen will remain closed for the preparation and serving of hot food until the planned refurbishment has been completed. Discussions are taking place as to how and when this can be done.

#### Events

Tafarn does not intend to hold any of its planned events until restrictions are lifted. It is felt they would not be viable with the limited numbers allowed to attend.

Tafarn premises are available for anyone wishing to hold an event after consultation with the management committee. Due to the restricted numbers allowed on the premises, the event should not be held on a bar opening night to avoid any inconvenience to regular bar users. Tickets should be issued in advance to restrict the attendance to 30.

#### Shop

The shop will continue to be open for four mornings per week, Tuesday to Friday. There are no plans at present to reopen on a Saturday morning.
