## PALE CASK ALES:

	<b>Pia Whanga</b>	Tenby Harbour Brewery	4.2%	Quintessentially New Zealand. Hops from the Land of the Long White Cloud provide strong flavours of lemon, lime and tropical fruits whilst Pacific Gem supports that fruity profile with distinct berry aromas and slight bitterness.
	<b>Thunder bird</b>	Glamorgan Brewing Co.	4.5%	Named after the Red Kites which are often spotted soaring in the skies above the brewery. Thunderbird is a proper Welsh IPA: complex, finely honed and refreshingly bitter.
	<b>Off The Rails</b>	Heart of Wales Brewery	4.0%	A refreshing malty pale ale brewed to support the Heart of Wales Line Trail. 10p from every pint sold will be donated towards the upkeep of the track.
	<b>WPA</b>	Evan Evans	4.1%	The classic Welsh Pale Ale. WPA has a lovely golden colour and a fresh taste, with hints of tropical fruit balanced by a delicious malty finish.
	<b>Caldey Lollipop</b>	Tenby Harbour Brewery	4.5%	British Golden malt provides caramel and toffee flavours that create a delicious and moreish ale, whilst American and NZ hops add an amazing fruity and citrus taste with a touch of floral aroma
	<b>Sea Bass</b>	Tenby Harbour Brewery	3.9%	Aptly named for it's combination of British and French ingredients, which provide a malty-sweet biscuit backbone along with subtle floral aromas combined with flavours of cherry and strawberry.
	<b>Welsh Pale</b>	Glamorgan Brewing Co.	4.2%	A super drinkable pale ale designed for long afternoons down the local. With notes of citrus and tropical fruit, Welsh pale is easy going, approachable and impossible to resist. Goldings, Columbus, Admiral and Amarillo hops.
	<b>DAI PA</b>	Cardigan Brewery	4.8%	A cloudy Mountain India Pale ale with pine aromas and rich with a sherberty citrus fruit taste.
	<b>Koala</b>	Zoo Brew	3.5%	Koala is a light session ale with biscuit aromas and a robust hop base. Crafted from lager and cara malts and bittered with the strong flavoured Phoenix and Galena hop varieties.




## GOLDEN CASK ALES:

	<b>Sunny Dai</b>	Cardigan Brewery	4.3%	A light golden coloured beer brewed with a late addition of American hops with notes of marmalade and coriander seeds to give a rich fruit and spice character. Untappd Community Awards winner 2023.
	<b>Seascape</b>	Evan Evans	4.6%	A refreshing, vibrant golden malty beer with a lemon lime nose. Brewed using quality malts and hops sourced from around the world. A new beer for 2022.
	<b>North Star</b>	Tenby Harbour Brewery	4.2%	Smooth, malty amber ale blending herbal bitterness finishing with spicy blackcurrant and lemon aroma. Brewed using Crystal, Amber and Maris Otter malts with British First Gold and Brambling Cross Hops.
	<b>Cwrw</b>	Evan Evans	4.2%	An international award winner with a rich malty flavour and a distinct fruity palate, its a great beer for any occasion. Bronze medal winner at International Brewing Awards 2011. Simply a great Welsh Beer!
	<b>Warrior</b>	Evan Evans	4.6%	Winner of the Silver Medal at SIBA Wales and Western Section beer awards. A classic premium ale, distinctive and full bodied. Malty and fruity with a dry hop finish. A superb premium beer.
	<b>Jemima's Pitchfork</b>	Glamorgan Brewing Co.	4.5%	A refreshing, crisp pale golden beer brewed with Citra and Eldorado hops giving a brilliant undertone of citrus, pear and melon. Named after Jemima Nicholas who ended 1797 Battle of Fishguard armed with only a pitchfork.
	<b>Hop Zest</b>	Evan Evans	4.4%	A soft light straw coloured ale, with a crisp, clean hop aroma. The perfect ale for Summer refreshment.
	<b>Cwrw Gorslas</b>	Glamorgan Brewing Co.	4.0%	Named after the village in Carmarthenshire where the brewery first set up. This well balanced cwrw is a love letter to the classic bitters we grew up on. Challenger, Goldings and US Cascade hops.
	<b>Best Bitter</b>	Evan Evans	4.0%	A rich, malty session bitter with a fruit aroma. Brewed with winter barley malt, Fuggles and Goldings hops.

## RED CASK ALES:

	<b>Whiskey in the jar</b>	Tudor Brewery	4.5%	A medium amber ale infused with sour mash bourbon. (V & GF)
	<b>Big Red Chopper</b>	Heart of Wales Brewery	4.3%	A rich chestnut ale brewed in support of the Wales Air Ambulance. 10p from every pint sold is donated towards keeping the big red chopper in the air and saving lives across Wales.
	<b>RSA Sir Galahad</b>	Tenby Harbour Brewery	4.6%	A delicious blend of British and German malts provide a complex malt character with a rich ruby red colour. A blend of British First Gold, Pioneer, Cascade and Willamette hops provide cedar, grapefruit and floral aromas.
	<b>Wrecker</b>	Evan Evans	4.5%	A superb full bodied, easy drinking ale with a malty body and hedgerow fruit hop finish.

## DARK CASK ALES:

	<b>Dirty Dai</b>	Cardigan Brewery	4.8%	Made with roasted malts to create a disgustingly dark beer with caramel & chocolate flavours and a subtle coffee aroma.
	<b>Welsh Black</b>	Heart of Wales Brewery	4.4%	A fine complex and particularly smooth stout, full of flavour with notes of liquorice. It was voted winner in its class at the CAMRA Great Welsh Beer & Cider Festival in June 2009.
	<b>Black Rock Porter</b>	Tudor Brewery	5.6%	A smooth dark ale made with chocolate malt that tastes as velvety as it looks. Made for the 'real' real-ale drinker. SIBA silver award 2020, Silver Champion Beer of Wales 2018 (V & GF)

## BOTTLE ALES:

	<b>M.V. Enterprise</b>	Tenby Harbour Brewery	4.0%	Our flagship ale. Brewed using British malts combined with American Cascade hops which gives this beer a malty-sweet base with a well-balanced bitterness with a fruity aroma.
	<b>Welsh Cake Stout</b>	Glamorgan Brewing Co.	4.8%	A pastry stout inspired by our favourite sweet treat. Adding oats and raisins to a rich stout base means every sip tastes of fresh Welsh cakes straight from the griddle. Brambling Cross and Challenger hops.
	<b>Waterwitch</b>	Tenby Harbour Brewery	5.2%	A classic blend of Maris Otter malted barley and Cara malt with newly developed Harlequin and Olicana hops, Waterwitch is a true celebration of British ingredients!
	<b>The Sheriff</b>	Tenby Harbour Brewery	4.2%	Like the sheriff of Carmarthenshire, British Maris Otter malts provide a reliable and solid platform, whilst Cara Gold gives this beer its rich golden hue with hints of caramel.
	<b>Black Mountain Stout</b>	Tudor Brewery	4.0%	A smooth stout, with good body and has a light brown head that settles to a thin covering. Rich, chocolate and caramel flavours. Silver Champion Beer of Wales 2015 (V & GF)
	<b>Amman Eagle</b>	Zoo Brew	4.4%	A crisp golden ale with a refreshing lime finish. Goes down exceptionally easy so you may struggle to stop at just the one... make sure you stock up! Brewed with Lager and Cara malts and Challenger and Speciality hops.
	<b>Jemima's Pitchfork</b>	Glamorgan Brewing Co.	4.5%	A refreshing, crisp pale golden beer brewed with Citra and Eldorado hops giving a brilliant undertone of citrus, pear and melon. Named after Jemima Nicholas who ended 1797 Battle of Fishguard armed with only a pitchfork.
	<b>Black Rock Porter</b>	Tudor Brewery	5.6%	A smooth dark ale made with chocolate malt that tastes as velvety as it looks. Made for the 'real' real-ale drinker. SIBA silver award 2020, Silver Champion Beer of Wales 2018 (V & GF)

## BOTTLE CIDERS:

Med Dry	<b>Dabinett</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	6.0%	Made from a single variety of apple, Dabinett is a full bittersweet apple found in large quantities throughout many Welsh orchards. This produces a well-balanced bittersweet cider with a soft astringency and full body. (GF) (V)
Med	<b>Old Crow</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	7.4%	This outrageous cider will blow your tastebuds to bits. Don't be fooled by its pale gold colour, this is one mighty mouthful. (GF) (V)
Med	<b>Farmhouse Scrumpy</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	5.3%	An exquisite rich and golden coloured cider with a crisp medium taste. Full of flavour with an aroma coupled with our mature vintage ciders. (GF) (V)
Fruit	<b>Autumn Magic</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	4.0%	Once opened Autumn Magic Cider with Blackberry bursts with a fruity aroma, reminiscent of enchanting autumn days. (GF) (V)
Med	<b>Orchard Gold</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	4.9%	Golden medium cider with a refreshing apple aroma. Smooth balanced flavour that has a fresh, crisp sharpness. (GF) (V)
Med Sweet	<b>Perry Vale</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	4.5%	A pear perry which is a blend of three varieties of pears that have been allowed to ferment and mature slowly. (GF) (V)
Med	<b>Vintage Scrumpy</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	5.3%	Have you ever heard of someone talk about old fashioned cloudy scrumpy?..... One taste of ours and all will be revealed. Our cloudy scrumpy is a medium dry cider with a fresh apple aroma. (GF) (V)
Med Dry	<b>Gold Medal</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	7.0%	Our first commercially produced cider which won the CAMRA Gold Medal back in 2004 – the first Welsh cider producer to achieve a coveted gold medal. (GF) (V)
Med	<b>Black Dragon</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	7.2%	Hand crafted from apples grown by traditional methods in ageing orchards. The juice pressed is fermented and matured in oak barrels to produce a cider rich in colour, body and flavour with a fresh fruity aroma. (GF) (V)

## NON - ALCOHOLIC ALES:

	<b>New World Lager</b>	Drop Bear Brewery	0.5%	Inspired by new world hop varieties from the Southern Hemisphere, a punchy IPL (India Pale Lager). Notes of honey, biscuit, and toasted malts balance strong hop notes of lemon, lime, and candied mandarin. (GF) (V)
	<b>Yuzu Pale Ale</b>	Drop Bear Brewery	0.4%	Dry hopped with refreshing floral and grapefruit hops, a splash of yuzu bursts through the toffee base. Wondering what a yuzu is? Well, it tastes like a combination of lemon, lime, and grapefruit...super refreshing! (GF) (V)
	<b>Tropical IPA</b>	Drop Bear Brewery	0.3%	Dry hopped with juicy US hops, tropical hop notes of citrus, passionfruit, and stone fruit are complemented by delicate malt notes of caramel. Winner of a gold medal at the European Beer Challenge Awards 2022. (GF) (V)
	<b>Bonfire Stout</b>	Drop Bear Brewery	0.5%	Inspired by the traditional Irish stout, this dark beer provides a dry yet refreshing and lightly hopped finish. Notes of roasted coffee balance flavours of dark chocolate and caramel. (GF) (V)
