## PALE CASK ALES:

	<b>Pia Whanga</b>	Tenby Harbour Brewery	4.2%	Quintessentially New Zealand. Hops from the Land of the Long White Cloud provide strong flavours of lemon, lime and tropical fruits whilst Pacific Gem supports that fruity profile with distinct berry aromas and slight bitterness.
	<b>Super Hero</b>	Tudor Brewery	4.5%	A Welsh brewed American pale ale brewed with American Simcoe hops from Yakima Chief Ranches. This is a well balanced, crisp tasting naturally hazy ale and has all the power of an American Super hero. (GF)(V)
	<b>Caldey Lollipop</b>	Tenby Harbour Brewery	4.5%	British Golden malt provides caramel and toffee flavours that create a delicious and moreish ale, whilst American and New Zealand hops add an amazing fruity and citrus taste with a touch of floral aroma to this hoppy session IPA.
	<b>WPA</b>	Evan Evans	4.1%	The classic Welsh Pale Ale. WPA has a lovely golden colour and a fresh taste, with hints of tropical fruit balanced by a delicious malty finish.
	<del><b>Seafire</b></del>	<del>Cardigan Brewery</del>	<del>4.4%</del>	<del>A West Coast IPA inspired by our surrounding unspoiled environment. A pale 'hop forward' brew, with a solid bitterness &amp; finished with dry malt &amp; late added hops promoting touches of bold citrus and pine aroma.</del>
	<b>Trawlers Dread</b>	Tenby Harbour Brewery	5.4%	A mixture of malts combined with Simcoe and Citra hops create a strong yet deliciously fruity flavoured beer, topped off with a hint of a fresh sea breeze provided by Dulse seaweed plucked straight off the Pembrokeshire coastline!
	<b>Moho</b>	Mantle Brewery	4.3%	Robust & aromatic Welsh Pale ale, finely balanced for a full on flavour treat.
	<b>Welsh Pale Ale</b>	Glamorgan Brewing	4.1%	A super drinkable pale ale designed for long afternoons down the local. With notes of citrus and tropical fruit, Welsh Pale is easy going, approachable and impossible to resist.
	<b>Heist</b>	Tenby Harbour Brewery	5.0%	A Belgian IPA with a tasty combination of moreish malt flavours with European hop aroma and subtle bitterness, along with fruity notes from traditional Belgian yeast.
	<b>Caban</b>	Two Rivers Brewery	4.1%	A refreshing pale ale, single-hopped with Citra. With a long, hoppy finish, this beer is already a favourite. Named after where quarrymen would gather to eat, and celebrate Welsh culture.

## GOLDEN CASK ALES:

	<b>Sunny Dai</b>	Cardigan Brewery	4.3%	A light golden coloured beer brewed with a late addition of American hops with notes of marmalade and coriander seeds to give a rich fruit and spice character. Untappd Community Awards winner 2023.
	<b>Seascape</b>	Evan Evans	4.6%	A refreshing, vibrant golden malty beer with a lemon lime nose. Brewed using quality malts and hops sourced from around the world.
	<b>Skirrid</b>	Tudor Brewery	4.2%	The Skirrid is a peak overlooking Abergavenny and this Welsh Bitter is every bit as distinctive. A full of flavour dark golden beer ideal for lovers of strong flavoursome beer. (GF)(V)
	<b>Smugglers Reef</b>	Evan Evans	4.4%	A full flavoured, dark golden ale with a moreish flavour from its rewarding hoppy character.
	<b>Rock Steady</b>	Mantle Brewery	3.8%	Golden session ale, with great depth of flavour. Satisfying & refreshing.
	<b>Jemima's Pitchfork</b>	Glamorgan Brewing Co.	4.5%	A refreshing, crisp pale golden beer brewed with Citra and Eldorado hops giving a brilliant undertone of citrus, pear and melon. Named after Jemima Nicholas who ended 1797 Battle of Fishguard armed with only a pitchfork.
	<b>Triumph</b>	Evan Evans	4.4%	A welcome return for this autumnal beer. Triumph is a rich, malty amber ale with a berry fruit aroma.
	<b>Golau</b>	Two Rivers Brewery	4.0%	A lovely Blonde ale, sweet, smooth and refreshing
	<b>Cwrw Gorslas</b>	Glamorgan Brewing	4.0%	Named after the village in Carmarthenshire where the brewery first set up. This well balanced cwrw is a love letter to the classic bitters we grew up on. Challenger, Goldings and US Cascade hops.
	<del><b>Wrecker</b></del>	<del>Evan Evans</del>	<del>4.5%</del>	<del>A full bodied, easy drinking ale with a malty body and hedgerow fruit hop finish</del>

## DARK CASK ALES:







	<b>Black Rock Porter</b>	Tudor Brewery	5.6%	A smooth dark ale made with chocolate malt that tastes as velvety as it looks. Made for the 'real' real-ale drinker. SIBA silver award 2020, Silver Champion Beer of Wales 2018 (GF)(V)
	<b>Stowt</b>	Two Rivers Brewery	4.3%	A rich chocolatey stout with hints of liquorish.
	<b>Black Mountain Stout</b>	Tudor Brewery	4.0%	A smooth stout with a good body that has a light brown head that settles to a thin covering. Rich chocolate and caramel flavours. Silver Champion beer of Wales 2015 (GF)(V)
	<b>Dark Heart</b>	Mantle Brewery	5.2%	A rich dark ruby porter, delicately brewed with two British hop varieties, and a subtle spiced edge.

## BOTTLE ALES:

	<b>M.V. Enterprise</b>	Tenby Harbour Brewery	4.0%	Our flagship ale. Brewed using British malts combined with American Cascade hops which gives this beer a malty-sweet base with a well-balanced bitterness with a fruity aroma.
	<b>Welsh Cake Stout</b>	Glamorgan Brewing Co.	4.8%	A pastry stout inspired by our favourite sweet treat. Adding oats and raisins to a rich stout base means every sip tastes of fresh Welsh cakes straight from the griddle. Brambling Cross and Challenger hops.
	<b>RSA Sir Galahad</b>	Tenby Harbour Brewery	4.6%	A delicious blend of British and German malts provide a complex malt character with a rich ruby red colour. A blend of British First Gold, Pioneer, Cascade and Willamette hops provide cedar, grapefruit and floral aromas.
	<b>Dai Cockles</b>	Cardigan Brewery	5.4 %	Dark ruby Coloured ale with rich malt flavours balanced against a spicy bitter hop finish.
	<b>Cwrw Teifi</b>	Mantle Brewery	4.5%	Full bodied malt driven best bitter with a well balanced & pleasant hop finish.
	<b>Dirty Dai</b>	Cardigan Brewery	4.8%	A fabulous porter made with roasted malts to create a stunning dark beer with caramel and chocolate flavours and a subtle coffee aroma.
	<b>Dead Canary</b>	Glamorgan Brewing	5.0%	A well hopped IPA with a properly refreshing bitter finish. Brewed to honour the coal mine canaries that made the ultimate sacrifice, this liquid eulogy is a knockout.

## BOTTLE CIDERS:

<small>Med Dry</small>	<b>Dabinett</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	6.0%	Made from a single variety of apple, Dabinett is a full bittersweet apple found in large quantities throughout many Welsh orchards. This produces a well-balanced bittersweet cider with a soft astringency and full body. (GF) (V)
<small>Med</small>	<b>Old Crow</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	7.4%	This outrageous cider will blow your tastebuds to bits. Don't be fooled by its pale gold colour, this is one mighty mouthful. (GF) (V)
<small>Med</small>	<b>Farmhouse Scrumpy</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	5.3%	An exquisite rich and golden coloured cider with a crisp medium taste. Full of flavour with an aroma coupled with our mature vintage ciders. (GF) (V)
<small>Fruit</small>	<b>Autumn Magic</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	4.0%	Once opened Autumn Magic Cider with Blackberry bursts with a fruity aroma, reminiscent of enchanting autumn days. (GF) (V)
<small>Med</small>	<b>Orchard Gold</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	4.9%	Golden medium cider with a refreshing apple aroma. Smooth balanced flavour that has a fresh, crisp sharpness. (GF) (V)
<small>Med Sweet</small>	<b>Perry Vale</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	4.5%	A pear perry which is a blend of three varieties of pears that have been allowed to ferment and mature slowly. (GF) (V)
<small>Med</small>	<b>Vintage Scrumpy</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	5.3%	Have you ever heard of someone talk about old fashioned cloudy scrumpy?..... One taste of ours and all will be revealed. Our cloudy scrumpy is a medium dry cider with a fresh apple aroma. (GF) (V)
<small>Med Dry</small>	<b>Gold Medal</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	7.0%	Our first commercially produced cider which won the CAMRA Gold Medal back in 2004 – the first Welsh cider producer to achieve a coveted gold medal. (GF) (V)
<small>Med</small>	<b>Black Dragon</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	7.2%	Hand crafted from apples grown by traditional methods in ageing orchards. The juice pressed is fermented and matured in oak barrels to produce a cider rich in colour, body and flavour with a fresh fruity aroma. (GF) (V)

## NON - ALCOHOLIC ALES:

	<b>Ghost Ship</b>	Adnams	0.5%	Adnams Ghost Ship is a popular, award-winning citrus pale ale brewed in Southwold, Suffolk, known for its distinct lemon and lime flavours and biscuity hoppy finish.
	<b>Erdinger 0%</b>	Erdinger Weißbräu	0.5%	A traditional Bavarian wheat beer with a Hazy golden appearance with banana, clove, and soft wheat malt notes, often described as having a full-bodied feel and a clean finish.
	<b>Guinness 0.0</b>	Diageo	0.0%	Traditional Guinness and gently removing the alcohol via cold filtration. It retains the iconic dark, creamy, ruby-red, roast-malt character of standard Guinness, providing a premium alternative with similar chocolate and coffee notes
	<b>Orchard Zero</b>	Gwynt y Ddraig	0.5%	A refreshingly low - alcohol Cider with a typically Gwynt crisp apple finish. (V)
	<b>Red Hog Cider</b>	Evan Evans	0%	A delicious clear sparkling cider, with the perfect balance of subtle sweetness and intense apple flavour. Great depth and a rounded mouthfeel make this refreshing, bold cider the perfect thirst-quencher, whatever the occasion (GF) (V)
	<b>Red Hog Cider Fruit</b>	Evan Evans	0%	Ripe blackberries, blackcurrants and strawberries combine with a crisp apple base to create this lively cider. With its fruity aroma and berry flavours, it captures the delicious freshness of Summer fruit without being overly sweet.
